- 【 3 】 ①Selma
- The Netherland/Red/Ball-shaped bloom
 - The deepest red among the hydrangeas in the flower garden.
- 【 】 ②Blue Temari
- Japan/Light Blue/Ball-shaped bloom
 - A hydrangea native to Japan, which turns bright blue in acid soil.
- Fully bloomed in mid- June.
- 【 】 ③Sabrina
- The Netherland/Pink/Ball-shaped bloom
 - The part around the flower bud turns deep pink.
- 【 】 ④Sumidanohanabi
- Japan/White/Lace cap bloom
 - The white petals around the flower bud look like sparklers have burst.
- 【 】 ⑤Annabel
- U.S.A/White/Ball-shaped bloom
 - The flowers start as light green and change from white to light green and bloom on the new shoots in spring.
- 【 】 ⑥Benigaku
- Japan/White→Red/Lace cap bloom
 - The flowers start with white petals, which turn red as they mature.
- 【 】 ⑦Marine Blue
- Japan/Deep Blue/Ball-shaped bloom
 - It' s a vigorous plant with deep blue flowers and is easy to be grown.
- 【 】 ⑧Pink Temari
- Japan/Pink/Ball-shaped bloom
 - A hydrangea native to Japan, which turns bright blue in alkaline soil.
- 【 】 Fully bloomed in mid- June.
- 【 】 ⑨Sharona
- The Netherland/Seven transformations/Ball-shaped bloom
 - The flower bracts grow large like a ball, and soil conditions bring out subtle shades of color.
